

ENVIRONMENTAL PERFORMANCE

Egatel is an organization committed to sustainable business development, prevention of pollution and protection of the environment. Environmental sustainability and environmental impact due to the development of the activity are a priority for the organization and therefore:

- | Performs a continuous improvement of its environmental performance through the periodic monitoring of the marked objectives, environmental indicators and evaluation of direct and indirect environmental aspects.
- | It implements operational controls to reduce and manage the consumption of natural resources, raw material, generation of waste, discharges, emissions into the atmosphere, generation of noise and affecting the soil.
- | It establishes preventive measures for the minimization / elimination of the impacts derived from the significant environmental aspects: generation of electronic waste, consumption of electrical energy, fuel and plastic packaging.
- | The waste generated is managed through authorized managers. Egatel is a member of the ECOTIC foundation, whose objective is the management of electronic equipment produced and marketed by associated members at the end of their useful life.
- | The R & D department sets design policies aimed at the development of energy efficient, high performance equipment with lower cooling requirements.
- | Egatel has established and implemented protocols for action against possible environmental emergencies and has a system in place to update environmental legislation and identify applicable legal requirements.
- | The environmental aspects associated with the activity of Egatel are presented below. An operational control is performed on them in order to minimize the associated impacts.
